#### **Full (Ordinary, Senior, Family/Partner and Junior Membership)**

Members belong to both the BBKA and the DBKA. They will hold basic BDI insurance. They are issued with a national BBKA membership number, magazine (BBKA posted monthly and DBKA quarterly email), have access to all national and local events, local blogs, forums, learning courses, learning apiaries, groups, facilities, mentorship, can opt to be included on the swarm collecting list and AHT list, can attend local meetings and vote at DBKA AGMs.

- \*Family or Partner Membership - members should live in the same address as the ordinary / senior membership
- Senior Membership (ages 60+) - this is not a national scheme, but a subsidised full membership by the Derbyshire group. All members are registered with the BBKA as full members.

#### **Associate Membership**

Members belong only to the DBKA and are not registered with the BBKA. They have all the benefits of the local group - such as the DBKA quarterly email, access to local events, local blogs and forums, learning courses, learning apiaries, groups, facilities, mentorship, can opt to be included on the swarm collecting list and AHT list and can attend local meetings.

They do not receive BBKA benefits such as basic BDI insurance (unless registered with a different association), the National BBKA monthly magazine, a national committee vote, access to the BBKA web and national meetings.
